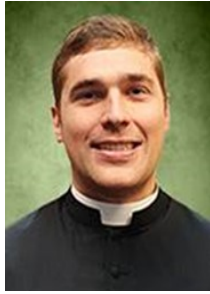


*Congratulations to Father Bryan Kuhr!

Dear Staff and Parishioners of Our Lady of the Mountains,

My name is Rubén Núñez. I am a native of Mexico, but I have been living in Georgia since 1999. Before entering seminary, I was studying psychology in Dalton State College, in Dalton, GA, where my family lives. I did my college seminary in St. Joseph Abbey and Seminary College in Covington, LA. I am currently studying in St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary in Boynton Beach, FL.
