



CFF registration has begun!

¡Las inscripciones para las clases de formación Católica ha comenzado!

Our Catholic Faith Formation Program provides classes for Pre-School (3 years old), Pre-K (4 years old), Kindergarten, and Grades 1 through 12.

To be enrolled in our Program, each family needs to turn in a **CFF Registration Form** and an **Annual Medical Release Form**. Forms are available in the Narthex and downstairs in the Parish Hall by the CFF office. A copy of the child's **Baptismal Certificate** is required along with a copy of the certificate for any other Sacraments they may have received at another parish.

The Registration Fee is \$75.00 per child for Pre-School through 8th Grade, \$90.00 per child for Grades 9–12 with a maximum of \$225.00 per family. Additional Sacramental Fees are \$25.00 for First Penance/First Communion, and \$50.00 for Confirmation. Payments may be made in three increments. No family should fail to enroll their child/children because of the expense. If there is a problem, speak with Scott Curran. Scholarships are available, if needed.

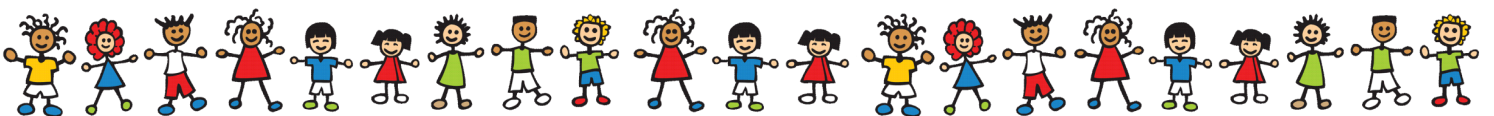

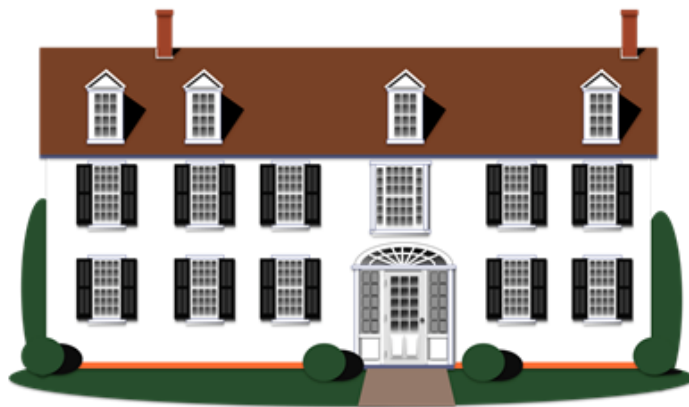
Las clases se darán a los siguientes grados escolares: Pre-school (3 y 4 años), Kindergarten y los grados 1 al 12.

Para inscribirse en nuestro programa cada familia debe de llenar el formulario de registración y una forma médica anual. Las formas están disponibles en el Narthex de la iglesia y en la oficina de Señor Scott Curran (en el sótano de la iglesia). Es necesario traer su certificado de bautizo y copia de los sacramentos que hayan recibido.

La inscripción para Pre-school hasta el octavo grado es de \$75.00/alumno y del grado 9 al 12 el costo es de \$90.00/alumno con un monto máximo de \$225.00 por familia. El costo adicional para el sacramento de la Comunión es de \$25.00 y de \$50.00 para el sacramento de Confirmación. Los pagos se pueden hacer en 3 partes. Todos los pagos deben de ser hechos 45 días antes de recibir el sacramento.

The Seton Home School Consortium has openings for parents and their children grades K-12 for the 2018-19 school year. The Seton Consortium is a group of home school parents and skilled tutors and advisors who come together two full days each week at Our Lady of the Mountains for tutorial support within a Catholic sacramental environment. Our program supplements parent home teaching throughout the week. The Consortium meets Mondays and Thursdays at OLM. At the Consortium, parents conduct their daily teaching routine in tandem with tutors in a positive learning and social environment. Parents who work or who have other responsibilities have the option of leaving their children at the Consortium for full-day supervision and tutoring. Focusing on the Catholic sacramental life, the children interact with each other through Mass attendance at 9:30 a.m., prayers several times throughout the day, religious and spiritual discussions and presentations, and various games and activities at lunch time and recess. Parents also have the opportunity to organize group educational field trips to various religious and community sites.
