

St. Augustine Pilgrimage

June 10th–14th, 2019

We invite all current 8th–12th graders at Our Lady of the Mountains to join us on a Pilgrimage to St. Augustine, Florida the week of June 10th–14th, 2019.

We will be accompanied on the Pilgrimage by our own Fr. Byrd. The itinerary is as follows:

- **Leave** Our Lady of the Mountains by bus the morning of Monday, June 10th, and return Friday, June 14th.
- **Stay** at the beautiful Historic Flagler College in the town of St. Augustine.
- **Events** include touring the birthplace of the Catholic Church in the United States at the Mission Nombre de Dios, the historic old Cathedral, the Old Spanish Town, and the Castillo San Marcos, playing at the beach, eating at great places, enjoying fellowship, and learning more about your faith with Fr. Byrd.
- **Mass** will be held at LaLeche Chapel at the Mission site where the first Mass was celebrated.

Total Cost is \$200 per student and includes all of the above (you will have to supply your own spending money). The total cost can be broken up into payments, but a deposit is needed to reserve a place.
