Quinceanera Registration Form

If your family wishes to have a Quinceanera at Our Lady of the Mountains, please answer the following questions. Note that answers regarding registration and class attendance will be verified with the Parish Office and our catechists.

- Yes or No Our family is registered as parishioners at Our Lady of the Mountains and has been for at least one year.
- Yes or No Our family takes our Catholic Faith seriously, we go to Mass weekly, and we regularly contribute to our parish offertory .
- Yes or No Our daughter has been enrolled in Religious Education in the parish for at least two years or more, and she regularly attends her catechetical classes.
- Yes or No Our daughter attends the Living in the Light classes of OLM's Religious Education program, was registered at least by the age of 14, and has attended classes for a minimum of ONE year.
- Yes or No We understand that a Quinceanera is not a Sacrament, and that the Church wants us to make sure our children live a sacramental life in the Church first and foremost.

Yes or No Our daughter has been baptized and we have included a photocopy of her Baptismal Certificate.

Yes or No Our daughter has received her First Holy Communion and we have included a photocopy of her First Holy Communion certificate.

Yes or No Our daughter has received the Sacrament of Confirmation and we have included a photocopy of her Confirmation certificate.

Yes or No Our daughter has not yet been Confirmed; she is being prepared to receive her Confirmation.

Please note that if your daughter has already received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation, regardless, she MUST be enrolled and attend a Religious Education class offered at the parish, starting at the age of 14, for a minimum of ONE year.

Yes or No We understand that if the Quinceanera is to occur at a private Mass, that Mass will be on a Saturday at 1 p.m. and cost \$450.00. Plus an additional set up and clean up fee of \$150.00.

Yes or No We understand that if the Quinceanera is to occur during the regularly scheduled Saturday 6 p.m. Spanish Mass, the cost is \$250.00.

Yes or No We understand that we must leave the church by 2:30 pm if we have a 1pm Mass.

- Yes or No We understand that if the Quinceanera is to occur during the regularly scheduled Saturday 6 p.m. Spanish Mass, the cost is \$250.00.

- Yes or No We have included cash or a check for the fee for the Quinceanera.

- Yes or No We have given the parish at least 30 days notice, have fulfilled all the requirements, and wish to schedule our daughter's Quinceanera on the following date and time: _____

Flower Arrangements and Other Decorations You may have one small flower arrangement in front of the Virgin Mary statue, one in front of the St. Joseph statue, and one in front of the altar. No other flower arrangements, no balloons, and no other decorations will be allowed. *Remember, we are in a church in front of the Lord. Certain decorations are more appropriate for the banquet hall.*

A Quinceanera marks your daughter's transition from childhood to young womanhood. We know that this is important to your family. But let us be clear, too often families put too much importance on a Quinceanera to the neglect of the sacraments. They show up at the parish and expect us to provide this privilege without being serious in their own sacramental life as Catholics, and without ever having seriously supported our parish. Our Lady of the Mountains will not entertain the possibility of a Quinceanera if there is no indication that a family is taking their faith seriously. We're not doing this to be cruel or exclusory - we're insisting on this for the sake of our youth and our families, for the sake of the salvation of souls. So, if you want a Quinceanera at OLM, you need to be an active parishioner here. If that is the case, there will be no problems.
